

WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP NETWORK

Introduction: Founded in 2018 and led by a committee, the Mid Penn Bank Women's Leadership Network (WLN) was created as a way for female colleagues at all levels, to make connections, share knowledge and experiences, learn about leadership, and enrich their professional development journeys. Recognizing Mid Penn Bank's profound dedication to the communities it serves, the WLN formed a Small Grant Committee in 2021. The committee's goal is to have a direct impact outside of the walls of the bank and to encourage philanthropic skills, as a part of leadership development.

Grant Focus: Our goal is to support programs that educate and empower women and girls. The WLN is interested in supporting programs and initiatives that make a positive and direct impact on women and families in Pennsylvania. The grant program is open to nonprofit organizations impacting the following areas, including (but not limited to):

- Health and Wellness (including Mental Health)
- Human Services
- Education
- Housing Assistance
- Workforce Preparedness & Vocational skills

Eligibility requirements:

- Nonprofits must have confirmed charitable status as a 501(c)3 tax-exempt organization through the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). Agencies seeking funding through this grant program must confirm partnership with an appropriate organization or fiscal sponsor at the time a grant proposal is submitted, if 501(c)3 status is not yet established.
- Organizations must be located in or support the Mid Penn Bank service area.

Grant Funding Available: The WLN will be distributing grants of \$2,000 per organization, not to exceed a total of \$16,000 for this granting period.
